### Criteria for Selection of Recipient

The award should be based on activities of the applicant during the past four years. The 2009 award is based on activities for the years 2006-2009. The person should not be over 20 years old at the time of the application. This person should have registered Corriedale ewes, bred to a registered Corriedale ram and be in production for the four years of activities involved. Along with the application, please include a picture and a complete resume listing your various accomplishments with Corriedale sheep. The resume shall include the following items which this award is based on:

1. Production and management information on the flock for each of the four years.  
This includes number of brood ewes each year, lambing percentage, percent raised, and wool production
2. Participation in 4-H, FFA, school, church and other community activities. Include any leadership activities.
3. Participation in sheep promotion and sheep association activities.
4. Participation in Corriedale sheep shows and sales, with a report of accomplishments.
5. What Corriedales have meant to you and your intentions in the future with them.

The application from each person should include pictures of self and sheep, and a brief personal history.

This award is presented annually at the National Show and Sale in conjunction with the annual meeting. The 2008 Selden Whitmore award will be presented in Eaton, Ohio on May 10, 2008. The winner will receive a monetary award of \$150.00 and a traveling plaque on which they will have their name engraved.

The recipient will then return the plaque to the Executive Secretary the following spring prior to the annual meeting.
