* The State of Minnesota requires a certificate of veterinary inspection, with the premise ID as well as the individual animal scrapie tag number listed on the health certificate for each animal. If you have a different flock tag number, that number needs to be listed as well as an additional means of identification.

* The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection shall have the following:

State that the animals described are not showing clinical signs of infectious, contagious, or communicable disease and that they meet movement requirements.

State the number of animals in the shipment

Document official identification for each animal

Document the address and contact information for the premises of origin and the premises of destination.

State the results of any test that are required by the board

All rams born prior to February 1, 2019 must have a negative B. ovis test result listed on the CVI, along with a copy of the individual lab test result for each ram entered. The accession number and result MUST BE STATED ON THE HEALTH CERTIFICATE.

All rams must have a written statement of the CVI that the veterinarian issuing the CVI palpated the testicles of each ram and no abnormalities were found.

State the purpose for moving the animals

Breeding

Feeding

Direct to slaughter

Other (i.e. exhibition/show)

Document a permit number if required

Document any additional information as required by the Minnesota Animal Board of Health

Sheep and goats must be officially identified. No sheep or goat that is within 30 days of giving birth (either before or after) may be exhibited without prior approval from the Board.

***Please provide two (2) copies of the certified veterinary health inspection certificate as well as two (2) copies of the B. ovis negative test result for each entry that you have. Please have your veterinarian make those copies so that they are legible and are easily read. ENTRIES WITHOUT COPIES THAT ARE EASY TO READ AND VERY LEGIBLE WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO BE SHOWN OR SOLD. *** Copies made by the ARSBA copier/printer are usually not clear enough to read.
