1. Entry deadline is April 10, 2026 for sale #1 and May 1, 2026 for sale #2. All entries are to be mailed to: ARSBA, c/o Robbie Eckhoff, P.O. Box 214, Hawley, TX 79525. **Entry fees are NON-refundable and must be included at time entries are received. Please make checks payable to ARSBA. You may make entry via online Google Form and only send in summary sheets with your entry fees. If you opt to enter via the Google Form please note which sale the entry is for.**
2. **Entry fees for the Online Sales are \$20/head**; Futurity Nomination is an additional \$30/head;
3. Sale divisions for the Online Sales will be the same as the National Sale except there will be no pairs sold in the online sales.
4. Commission for the Online Sales will be 10% of the sales price or 10% of the minimum sales price that the consignor will take for each lot.
5. Please remember that transportation of sold animals is to be determined and decided between the buyer and the seller. Also, please remember that you as the consignor are responsible for all health certificates and/or test results to get each sale animal to its destination which includes a Negative B. Ovis test result for all rams born prior to February 1, 2026.
6. All animals sold must have a flock tag and scrapie tag, and those tag numbers must be provided to the ARSBA as well as Integrity Livestock Sales for record keeping purposes. In addition, ALL FUTURITY NOMINATED ewe lambs must provide a headshot that clearly shows the flock tag and scrapie tag to the ARSBA office as a record for the ARSBA futurity.
7. ALL SALE ENTRIES MUST BE REGISTERED PRIOR TO SALE DAY. IF ROBBIE DOES NOT RECEIVE PROOF OF REGISTRATION PRIOR TO SALE DAY THE SALE ENTRY(S) WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE SALE
8. You are responsible for taking care of transfer of ownership in a timely manner so that the new owner has the registration papers in hand for any reason that they may need them.
9. THE AMERICAN RAMBOUILLET SHEEP BREEDERS ASSOCIATION IS NOT THE ACTING AGENT BETWEEN THE SELLER AND THE BUYER. ANY DISPUTES ARE SOLELY THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SELLER AND THE BUYER.
