

CONSTITUTION & FINANCE

President Scott Crawford called the meeting to order at 1:10 PM CST. Woody Joslin made a motion to accept the 2015 minutes with a second by Sam Jackson. The motion passed to accept the 2015 minutes.

Woody gave an update on the appendage registry with the consensus of the appendage registry committee making the suggestion that the ARSBA not go forward with an appendage registry and the issue is currently dead.

The members in attendance reviewed the financials statements from calendar year 2015. Woody and Robbie presented what some of the associations are doing in allowing a catch up period for registrations of older animals, much like what the Hampshire Association had done previously.

Darin Bauck made a motion that the ARSBA have a 60 day amnesty period from November 1-December 31, 2016 to allow any sheep that is registerable of any age to be registered for the 12 month and under price. Justin Benz provided a second to the motion and the motion unanimously passed.

The consensus of the attendees felt that word of mouth and the newsletter was an acceptable form to get the word out, going back three to four years in obtaining a mailing list to get the newsletter or information to potential individuals to register sheep.

With no other business, Sam Jackson made a motion to adjourn the Constitution and Finance Meeting, with Matt Benz providing a second. With no discussion, the motion passed and the Constitution and Finance meeting was adjourned.
