

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING  
JULY 8, 2016  
PIPESTONE, MINNESOTA

President Scott Crawford called the meeting to order at 6:48 PM CST at which time he asked the Secretary to provide an update to the general membership of the meetings from July 7, 2016.

Robbie stated that in the Constitution and Finance meeting a motion was passed to have an Amnesty Program for registry of animals over 12 months of age and they would be registered for the 12 month and under fee. The period would be from November 1-December 31, 2016 and this will be a one time catch up opportunity for older or even deceased animals.

As the Associated Registry gets their software update complete a Breeders Directory will be on the website sorted by state as well as alphabetically.

Abby Ketterling made a proposal to host the 2017 National Rambouillet Show and Sale in Gillette, Wyoming June 26-July 1 2017. The proposal was accepted.

Junior Show will be Wednesday at 4:00 pm, and all Junior Show sheep must be checked in by 6:00 Tuesday.

Sale sheep must be in the barn and checked in by Noon on Wednesday.

It was suggested that a Junior Sheep Dress Up Contest should be held in 2017 as well as a Pee-Wee Showmanship Contest for youth ages 2-7 and all participants should get some type of small award for participating.

The Board of Directors will look at getting some new promotional materials and/or breeders directories printed in the future that may be used at shows and sales for promotion of the Rambouillet breed. Suggestions were the scorecard in the directory and to sell ads in the directory to offset the cost.
