Above is the production and performance data for the rams we have consigned to the Hettinger ram sale. We hope it is useful to you. Weaning percent is one of our primary culling considerations. Lot 25 is out of a ewe lamb. We have "town jobs" and our ewes often go 12+ hours during lambing without being checked so mothering ability is very important to us. The rams spent the summer on pasture and have been grown out to maintain soundness and longevity, not maximum gain.

We were very pleased to raise the high indexing ram at the 2008 fall ram test. The test measures ADG, clean fleece weight, and fiber diameter. We were also fortunate to raise the 2009 and 2010 National Champion Rams. It may seem odd that the same flock can achieve both of these accomplishments. This balance of correctness and performance has led to the sale of stud rams and ewes to some of the top Rambouillet producers in the country.
