

Flock Name- refers to all the sheep you raise.

Re-Christen Name- will be included on the ram's or ewe's certificate of their offspring.

Private ID tag or tattoo- is required for each sheep offered for registration

Birth Type- S single, TW twin, TR triplet. For over 4 born in litter use number of lambs instead of code

Sex should be indicated using the code letters: R ram and E ewe.

Birth date requires month, date, and year of birth.

Sire: be sure to give the name, private ID and registration number.

Dam: be sure to give the name, private ID and registration number.

Birth type of ewe: S single, TW twin, TR triplet, and QR quad.

Paternal Grand Sire: be sure to give the name, private ID and registration number.

Paternal Grand Dam: be sure to give the name, private ID and registration number.

Maternal Grand Sire: be sure to give the name, private ID and registration number.

Maternal Grand Dam: be sure to give the name, private ID and registration number.

% Texel of the animal being registered.

Transfers date of sale – name and address of new owner

### TSBS FEES

*Membership in the Association is **not** required before registering animals. However all fees are **double***

**Annual Membership is \$25.00 June 1<sup>st</sup>- May 31<sup>st</sup>**

Junior Membership is free upon application. Valid until 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.

### TSBS Registration Fees

Registered purebred ewes: \$7.00

Registered purebred rams: \$15.00

( Registration fees double on ewes at 12 months of age. Rams at 24 months of age.)

Recorded up- graded ewes \$5.00

Recorded up – graded rams \$ 10.00

( Recorded rams may not be used for upgrading animals to be registered in TSBS, rather for show pedigree only)

### Transfer Fees

Transfer of ownership; Signed transfer form must be completed when applying for transfer.

Fees;

Application under 60 days from sale; \$5.00

Application over 60 days from sale; \$10.00

### Rules for Registering Percentage Texel Ewes:

Ewes offered to be registered with TSBS shall be sired by a registered Texel Ram.

Dams of these ewes do NOT have to be registered with another recognized breed association. You must provide known pedigree information on the dam and also provide the registration number of the Texel sire.

Ewe lambs will be considered “Registered Purebred” when they are 15/16 ths Texel pedigree. Rams will be considered “Registered Purebred” when they have reached 31/32 Texel pedigree.

#### Artificial Insemination

Texels born as a result of artificially inseminating the ewe must be designated as such. If the breeder does not own the ram from which semen was used to artificially inseminate the ewe then a copy of the Bill of Sale from the owner/agent of the ram collected will be required along with a copy of the registration form from a recognized Texel Association for that particular ram.

#### Embryo Transplant

Texels born as a result of embryo transplant may be registered just as if you were applying for registrations on naturally born lambs. Indicate “ET” in the type of birth column. Donor ewes utilized in an embryo transplant program must be registered either with the TSBS or another recognized Texel breed Association, and a copy of the the donor ewes pedigree is required. The owner of the donor ewe will be listed as the breeder on the certificate of registration. When embryos are sold, the lamb born as a result must be transferred from the owner of the donor ewe to the purchaser of the embryo.
