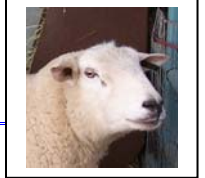

National Show and Sale, 2010 Highlights

Five different farms brought thirty seven head of fine looking Texels to Sedalia, Mo. for the National Show and Sale. Both the junior and open shows were held on Monday June 21, 2010. Results from those shows are in the following pages.

Monday evening, the TSBS banquet and annual meeting were held at the State Fair Best Western. Our dinner speaker was Guy Flora, editor of the *Shepherd* magazine. Mr. Flora's informative talk included the news that NSIP (National Sheep Improvement Plan) and Meat and Livestock Australia (MLA) put signatures to an agreement that will make LAMBPLAN available to U.S. sheep producers. This will make the data base much larger and expanded, and will include thousands more records. Although Australia is on the metric system, the records will also include English measurements.

Guy also pointed out that one of the major problems facing the U.S. sheep industry is lack of available lambs for slaughter. Because of this shortage, several packing houses have closed their doors, and others may soon follow. The demand for lamb is going up, at the same time that sheep numbers are declining.

Our thanks to Guy Flora, and his wife Pat, for joining us, and providing us with such interesting information.
