

ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION

Texels born as a result of artificially inseminating the ewe must be designated on the AI section of the bottom of this form. If the breeder does not own the ram from which semen was used to artificially inseminate the ewes, an AI form signed and dated by the owner of the semen and including all the other necessary information requested by the TSBS must be included at the time of the registry.

EMBRYO TRANSPLANT

Applications for lambs born as a result of embryo transplant may be submitted on the registration form just as you were applying for registrations on naturally born lambs. If a lamb was born as a result of Embryo Transplant indicate "ET" in the type of birth column. Donor ewes utilized in an embryo transplant program must be registered in the TSBS. The donor ewe's private flock name and number and TSBS registration number must be submitted when applying for registration on lambs born as a result of embryo transplant.

The owner of the donor ewe will be listed as the breeder on the certificate of registration issued on lambs born as a result of embryo transplant. When embryos are sold, the lamb born must be transferred from the owner of the donor ewe to the purchaser of the embryo.
