

At the March 2007 TSBS Board meeting the board recommended that lambs should be docked at the distal end of the caudal fold. Since it is also now a part of the "Judge's Scorecard," shorter lengths could hurt your animal's placing in the show ring, as well as being detrimental to the health of the animal. In many states this is now law, so if you want to sell a sheep into one of those states your sheep will need to be in compliance.
