

# HAMPSHIRE EWE LAMB FUTURITY

*Sponsored by the American Hampshire Sheep Association*

## PREMIUMS

A minimum of \$2000 will be awarded in premiums. The guaranteed money totals will be given as follows:

<b>First:</b>	<b>\$400 (20%)</b>
<b>Second:</b>	<b>\$300 (15%)</b>
<b>Third:</b>	<b>\$250 (12.5%)</b>
<b>Fourth:</b>	<b>\$225 (11.25%)</b>
<b>Fifth:</b>	<b>\$200 (10%)</b>
<b>Sixth:</b>	<b>\$175 (8.75%)</b>
<b>Seventh:</b>	<b>\$150 (7.5%)</b>
<b>Eighth:</b>	<b>\$125 (6.25%)</b>
<b>Ninth:</b>	<b>\$100 (5%)</b>
<b>Tenth:</b>	<b>\$75 (3.75%)</b>

*If total entry fee of ewe lambs nominated and donations are greater than the \$2000 total, premiums will be increased according to the percentages shown above.*

## POINT SCORING

1. A point record card has to be filled out for each showing and forwarded to the American Hampshire Sheep Association office **within 30 days of the show**. The card must be signed by the superintendent of the appropriate show, who must verify the youth owning the lamb did physically show the lamb unless physically impaired.

2. At each individual show the ewe lamb may earn futurity points from either the open division or junior division, but not both. However, at the North American Livestock Exposition (NAILE) only junior show placings will be counted.

3. Ewe lambs can compete at an unlimited number of shows with only the top five points awards used toward the Futurity final point totals.

4. **Double points will be awarded at the NAILE Junior show and either the All-American Junior Show, New England Youth Show, Western Regional Hamp Show at the Kansas State Fair, Oklahoma State Fair Junior Show, or the Oregon State Fair Junior Show.**

5. There will be one designated show for each state that the futurity ewe lamb must be shown at. The other four shows that make-up the point total may be any show of choice. The designated show in each state will be the State Fair of that particular state unless another show is designated by the state Hampshire Sheep Association. The following states have already designated these alternate shows as their Futurity state shows.

New Hampshire:	Cheshire Fair
Massachusetts:	Northeast Youth Sheep Show ( <i>double point show</i> )
Rhode Island:	Washington County Fair
Connecticut:	Woodstock Fair
Maine:	Fryeburg Fair
Pennsylvania:	Keystone International
Vermont:	Champaign Valley Fair
New Jersey:	Flemington Ag Fair
Maryland:	Eastern National
Georgia:	Georgia National

6. No designated show will be before the Midwest Stud Ram Sale.

7. Futurity awards will be announced following the junior show at the NAILE. Premiums will be mailed from the AHSA office to winners after the NAILE.

**CONSIGNOR RULES**

1. Entries are limited to fall & spring born ewe lambs.
2. Nomination fee is \$25.00 payable to the American Hampshire Sheep Association (AHSA). Ewe lambs must be nominated and designated prior to the sale.
3. Each ewe lamb must conform and abide by the rules and regulations of the individual sale to which it is consigned. All normal entry and commission fees apply.
4. The AHSA will not be held responsible for any dispute and/or disagreements between buyers and sellers.
5. Lambs will be permanently tagged with an official AHSA Futurity tag for futurity purposes prior to the sale of each animal.
6. Sales which are eligible to have futurity nominated ewe lambs are the following events: Wisconsin Invitational, Ohio Hampshire Showcase, Corn Belt Sale, Nugget Sale, Eastern Stud Ram Sale, Midwest Stud Ram Sale, Keystone Stud Ram & Ewe Sale, Cabaniss Production Sale, and the New England Sale.

**EXHIBITOR RULES**

1. Rules of exhibition shall be those published in respective premium books of each show. Ownership deadlines might vary from state to state.
2. All juniors who meet the requirements for the Junior Show at the North American Livestock Exposition are eligible. Rules for the NAILE are:
  - not to be more than 21 years of age the date of the show in November, no lower age limit but must be physically capable of showing his\her own sheep
  - Junior member must be present to show their own sheep unless physically impaired
  - Animals purchased must be transferred in the AHSA office. The date of sale will reflect the date of the appropriate above listed sales where the animal was purchased.
  - up to date membership in the American Hampshire Sheep Association
3. Juniors are responsible to be knowledgeable of and abide by these rules.
4. All lambs must be purchased through a public auction and bought and transferred directly to the youth. If the lamb is transferred out of the youth's name it will NO LONGER be eligible. No partnerships, farm, family, 4-H club or FFA chapter names will be accepted.
5. Ewe lambs and points earned in the futurity are not transferable to any other person other than the original owner, nor are the points transferable from one lamb to another.
6. No futurity entrant may compete with more than two ewe lambs. Total points earned by two ewe lambs cannot be combined to one lamb.
