Sale Rules & Terms

Arrival Time: The fairgrounds will be open to receive sheep at 2pm on Friday, October 30, 2009. Consignors will be responsible for paint branding their entries, equipment will be provided. Bedding will be provided.

Show: The show will start at 9:00 AM Saturday Oct 31th with minor breeds first, then Suffolks. The following classes for ewes will be used:

- Yearling Ewes
- Fall Ewe Lambs (September to December)
- January Ewe Lambs
- February Ewe Lambs
- Spring Ewe Lambs – Born after March 1, 2008
- Brood Ewes (Will not be shown)

Registration papers must be turned in to the sale secretary or entries will not sell. All entries must be in show condition & fitted to breed standards. Consignors will guarantee all yearling ewes to be bred. On open yearling ewes the refund from the consignor will be 20% of the purchase price. Ewe lambs may be open or exposed with no guarantee of pregnancy. Substitutions are allowed and will be marked with a bar under the lot number.

The Washington Suffolk Breeders Association or sale committee assumes no liability in regards to DNA testing. Any claims or guarantees made are strictly between the consignor and buyer.

All animals coming into Washington must have a health certificate in possession with each animal's tag number listed & all entries must have official ear tags or other official identification (tattoos) per federal regulations.

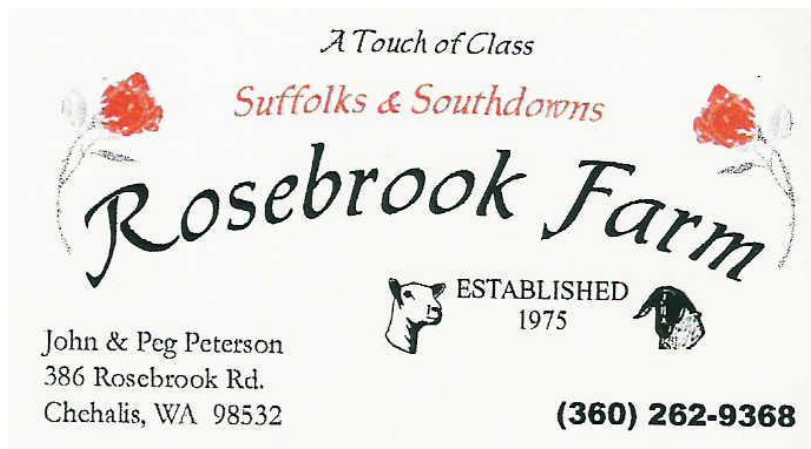
WA SUFFOLK BREEDERS YOUTH SKILL-A-THON
