

STARS OF LOUISVILLE SALE

If you are coming to Louisville for the North American, you might as well enter the Stars Sale!

**Rules & Regulations of the Stars of Louisville Hampshire Sale
Entry Blank is included as an attachment to this email.**

The following regulations govern entries for the Stars of Louisville Hampshire Sale held in conjunction with the North American International Livestock Exposition.

- 1. The Stars of Louisville Hampshire Sale will be held Saturday - November 14, 2009. Consignors need not be exhibitors at the North American Livestock Show.**
- 2. Consignors may reserve the right to show any sale animal in the National Hampshire Show, Wednesday November 18, 2009. Any sheep retained for show by the consignor will be released to the buyer immediately after the conclusion of the show. If show rights are reserved, it must be announced when the animal is selling. Transportation must be arranged between the buyer and seller.**
- 3. Classes - may be entered as follows: Yearling Ewe (YE), Senior Ewe Lamb (SEL) January Ewe Lamb (JEL), February Ewe Lamb (FEL), March Ewe Lamb (MEL) -- there are no rams in the sale.**
- 4. For ewes that are sold as bred, a breeding certificate must be turned in with the registration paper and health paper at check in time.**
- 5. All consignments must be accompanied by a health paper which meets the requirements of the State of Kentucky (see page 32 of the entry book or visit www.kyagr.com). A separate health paper is required for each animal! Each animal must carry a Federal Scrapie Tag.**
- 6. An entry fee of \$20 per head and 11% commission of the selling price will be charged. Commission will be paid by consignor even if entry fails to sell. Transfer fees will be deducted from the consignors settlement as well as any other indebtedness owed to AHSA.**

Entry Deadline is October 1, 2009.
