NTSRI Scholarship Rules:

- NTSRI will award 3 scholarships. The scholarships valued at \$1000.00 will be paid directly to the college after the completion of the first semester. The recipient must submit their first semester grades to the committee with a brief summary of the first semester. A minimum of a 2.5 GPA must be obtained to receive the scholarship.
- The scholarship is available to any member of NTSRI who is seeking post-secondary education in the fall of 2021. Students must begin college in the fall of 2021 to receive the award.
- The recipient may have won the scholarship before, if they present the scholarship committee with proof of grades during the time that they received the scholarship.
- The applicant or their parent must be a current member of NTSRI and have been a member in 2020 and have their 2021 dues paid by the application deadline of April 6, 2021. In addition, a member must have at least 2 sheep registered with the organization both years to be eligible to receive the scholarship.
- A copy of your resume should be included in the application.

The application deadline is April 6, 2021 and will be considered late if received after this date.

The Scholarship selection committee will review the applications and announce the winner(s) May, 2021 at the Ohio Showcase Sale in Greenville, OH if possible.

- B. The scholarship is available to any member of NTSRI who is seeking post-secondary education in the fall of 2021. Students must begin college in the fall of 2021 to receive the award.
- C. The recipient may have won the scholarship before, provided that they present the scholarship committee with proof of grades during the time that they received the scholarship.
- D. The applicant or their parent must be a current member of NTSRI, and have been a member in 2020 and have their 2021 dues paid by the application deadline of April 6, 2021. In addition a member must have at least 2 sheep registered with the organization both years to be eligible to receive the scholarship.
- E. A copy of your resume should be included in the application.
- F. The application deadline is April 6, 2021 and will be considered late if received after this date.

- G. The Scholarship selection committee will review the applications and announce the winner(s) prior to the Ohio Showcase Sale in Greenville, Ohio.
